A Dress Code will be enforced during the Awards Ceremony. To accept an award "on-stage," the student must wear the "Official SkillsUSA Uniform," State T-Shirt or the competition attire. NO SHORTS OR HATS!!!

## TASKS TO BE PERFORMED: All on <u>ONE</u> Magnum

- 1. Medium Men's Texture Cut
- 2. Pompadour Cut
- 3. Creative Design and Beard
- 4. Online Assessment- Completed by April 1(proctored)

\*Note: Proper sanitation must be maintained throughout the contest.

#### SUPPLIED BY TECHNICAL COMMITTEE:

4. One manikin will be used and will be provided by the State.

#### **SUPPLIED BY THE CONTESTANT:**

m. Clippies or hair clips

n. Labeled spray hospital-grade

disinfectant

o. Hand sanitizer

p. Protective cape (any style)

q. Tripod/Manikin stand

r. First Aid kit

s. #2 pencil and a blue or black pen

t. All competitors must create a one-page résumé and job application to be turned in at contest orientation. Copies must also be provided during the interview process.

u. Contestants must create a colored drawing of their creative haircut design with color application and beard design with beard coloring.

• Drawing should include a written description of the method used to create the design and a picture of the final design.

• Competitors will need two copies of their design theme, one is to be attached to their mirror during the competition and *must* be hand drawn.

• A hard copy of the résumé (v.) and drawing (w.) must be submitted to

the technical committee chair at as you enter the contest area.

. Failure to do so will result in a 10-point penalty.

**Note #1:** Any other items brought by the contestant will be subject to the approval of the Technical Committee and must be declared at the time of the site kit check.

**Note #2**: Contestants will not be released from the contest site after competition until the site (including floor) is cleaned up.

Note #3: Any item missing will have a 2 Point deduction will be assessed to Kit score

**Note #4:** Advisors and observers will be able to watch the competition at Fairgrounds. **<u>BUT</u>** anyone that is talking to a contestant will be asked to leave the competition area. **<u>NO ADVISORS</u>** are allowed to talk, communicate, or signal a contestant once students have entered into the competition area. Penalty points will be given and/or contestants may be disqualified along with Advisor being asked to leave the area.

# SCOPE OF THE CONTEST

Contestants will demonstrate their ability to perform jobs or skills selected from the following list of competencies as determined by the SkillsUSA Championships Technical Committee.

# **Technical Skills**

Competitors must be able to duplicate two predetermined haircuts/styles which have been selected by Indiana State Technical Committee.

# **CONTEST INSTRUCTIONS**

# Medium Textured Men's Cut: 45min.

Competitors will be provided with one photograph of a haircut to be completed on the uncut mannequin with beard. Contestants will be judged on quality of haircut and similarity to the photograph provided. Contestants will be judged on styling techniques, product usage, finishing and similarity to the photograph provided.

## Pompadour Haircut: 45 min

Contestants will be judged on their ability to create a textured look using shears and any texturizing tools they wish. They will finish the picture with products and any hot tool necessary to complete the style of the picture.

## **Creative Design and Beard: 90 min**

# Theme: Oceans and Marine

Contestants will be expected to complete a structured style that would be appropriate for a client going to a special event. Here is information directly from the national technical standards. Just remember you will be using the Pompadour cut manikin:

- Identify the theme of the creative freestyle design cut and beard design including hair color on paper and turn in a hard copy to the Technical Chairman the day of the contest. A second copy of the freestyle design should be with the contestant during the skill portion of the competition.

- Demonstrate fading, blending, sectioning, lining and finishing.

- Create a Creative Freestyle Design cut and beard design including hair and beard color. Any type of temporary hair color can be used. The haircut and beard should flow together for an overall look.

- Use appropriate styling products to duplicate the selected hair design.
- Demonstrate balance, proportion and form in the finished creative cut and beard design.

- Show control of texture and control of hair direction in the finished design.

- Incorporate current trends in both haircut, hair color and beard design.

- Follow all safety and sanitation procedures and maintain a clean area at all times.

# ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 1. No mannequins will be draped, have earrings, or jewelry of any kind.
- 2. NO CELL phones allowed during competition.
- 3. Contestants will be asked to display their completed Creative Design and Beard manikins for judges.
- 4. The first haircut may be done as the student interprets the picture. The competitor may use any appropriate tools to style the cut into the look of the picture. Keep in mind, this same mannequin will be used for all three events this year. Hair may not be trimmed from the beard on the mannequin until that portion of the contest begins.
- 5. Any contestant that leaves the competition floor will not be able to return to their station to fix or redo any part of the haircut/style, personalized design or back for any personal items.
- 6. Contestants may not talk, signal, or communicate in any way to spectators/instructors while competing in the competition area; contestants could be disqualified.
- 7. Remember you are representing your school as well as the SkillsUSA Organization; please be respectful to all contestants, advisors, and spectators.
- 8. Any complaints or grievances should be brought to the attention of the technical committee only. Do not talk to the competition judges.
- 9. Communication between any advisor and any student must reflect respectful and professional demeanor.
