CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:

- Scrubs
- White leather shoes
- ***NO SCHOOL LOGOS OR AFFILIATIONS ON CLOTHING OR MUST BE COMPLETELY COVERED.***

APPEARANCE REQUIREMENTS:

- A white T-shirt with crew neck may be worn under the scrub top as long as the shirt is not visible from either the sleeve or the hem areas.
- Conservative hairstyle- Long hair should be styled up and away from the face and neck.
- Nails should be cleaned, short, and without nail polish. No artificial nails (which can harbor bacteria).
- No heavy makeup, no heavy body scents, and no jewelry other than a watch and a wedding ring may be worn.
- Tattoos and piercings should not be visible.
- Competitors should exhibit professional appearance and conduct during the contest.

NO CELLPHONES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE CONTEST AREA DURING THE COMPETITION.

AWARDS CEREMONY DRESS CODE

PURPOSE:

To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of dental assisting.

STUDENTS MUST SUPPLY:

- Pen/pencil
- Goggles/eye protection
- lab coat

SCOPE OF CONTEST:

- 4-8 Stations
- Written test completed on testing platform between March 13-April 5.

Stations will consist of the following:

1. Instrument identification
 2. Special instrument identification-oral surgery instruments
 3. Taking alginate impressions & infection control
 4. Anesthetic assembly & disassembly
 5. Abbreviations- you will need to provide the correct words
 6. Oral Pathology identification – multiple choice test
 7. Identify teeth by names & numbers
 8. Suction placement & 4-handed dentistry transfer of instruments
 9. Dental Anatomy- identify the tooth
- *some of the stations will be combined into one station
