Contestants will not be able to talk to each other or ADVISORS during the competition or use cell phones.

PURPOSE:

To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of law enforcement and/or public security.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:

NO SCHOOL LOGO OR AFFILIATION ON ANY CLOTHING, MUST BE COVERED

1. Patrol Duty Pants or Dark Pants/Slacks (No Ornamentation/Striping)
2. Solid color oxford or polo style shirt
3. Patrol Duty Belt or regular black belt with necessary equipment (belt keepers, handcuffs, inner belt).
4. Solid black work shoes or boots (No high heels or tennis shoes) No more than ½" heels
5. Neatly groomed hair. Female hair style if long should be off shoulders as required by work standards. No ornamentation (bows, ribbons, headbands) Male hair style no longer than collar length and appropriate styles acceptable in general police work. No facial hair. No unnatural hair colors or styles for males or females. (ex. Mohawks, Pink highlights)
6. Female makeup: Neutral colors, no eye shadow color/glitter, nails neutral color only. Nails of short length.
7. No body piercings. Females allowed one pair of post style earrings only.

ALL CONTESTANTS MUST TURN IN A 1-PAGE RESUME AT THE BEGINNING OF THEIR CONTEST. THERE IS A 10 PT PENALTY IF NOT TURNED IN AT THIS TIME.

AWARDS CEREMONY DRESS CODE

A Dress Code will be enforced during the Awards Ceremony. To accept an award "on-stage", the student must wear the "Official SkillsUSA Uniform", State T-Shirt or the competition attire. NO SHORTS OR HATS!!!

EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS:
