Tasks to Be Performed:

Contestants will demonstrate their ability to perform jobs skills based on the Task list outlined by ASE and NATEF. The competition includes a series of workstations to assess skills in the following areas:

<u>Masking a vehicle for refinish-</u> Contestants are going to mask a fender and door for refinishing. each student will have similar vehicles. SOP's are attached. You may also go to: http://3mcollision.com/how-to/masking

<u>Fender Repair-</u> Contestants will prep a primed spot, refinish and blend within on a fender. They will be using Axalta Cromax solvent products. TSB and SDS sheets and SOP's are attached.

<u>Refinish a Panel Basecoat Clearcoat with Solvent</u> – Contestants are going to prep a panel for basecoat, clearcoat. They will be using Axalta Cromax products. TSB and SDS sheets and SOP's are attached.

<u>Prep and Refinish a Plastic Bumper Cover</u> – Contestants will take a bumper with traveling primer and prep, seal and refinish. They will be using Axalta Cromax products. TSB and SDS and SOP's sheets are attached.
