### PURPOSE

To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of medical assisting.

### CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:

*NO SCHOOL LOGO OR SCHOOL AFFILIATION ANYWHERE ON CLOTHING or IT MUST BE COVERED COMPLETELY*

- Appropriate program attire
  - Scrubs- A plain white crewneck T-shirt may be worn underneath the scrub top, and it should not be visible from the bottom of the sleeve or the bottom of the hem area of the scrub top. Hair must be pinned up and off the collar.
  - White socks or skin-tone seamless hose
  - Health professional's white or black work shoes
    - Shoes must be all-white or all-black (no canvas/mesh)
    - Completely enclosed (no open toe or open heel)
    - Athletic style shoes that meet the aforementioned criteria are acceptable
  - Jewelry as per medical standards
  - Tattoos covered.

### **\*AWARDS CEREMONY DRESS CODE\***

*A Dress Code will be enforced during the Awards Ceremony. To accept an award "on-stage", the student must wear the "Official SkillsUSA Uniform", State T-Shirt or the competition attire. NO SHORTS OR HATS!!!*

## **KNOWLEDGE PERFORMANCE**

Online portal testing dates are March 13-27, 2026, that will need to be proctored, proctor information sent in newsletter.

## **SKILLS PERFORMANCE**

The competition will consist of simulated office situations and demonstrations.
