- Competitors must wear their official competition attire as specified in the SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards

- Business casual attire

### **THURSDAY 6/4**

#### **SkillsUSA Championships**

- Competitors must wear their official competition attire as specified in the SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards

- Business casual attire

#### **Champions Festival**

- School-appropriate casual attire

### **FRIDAY 6/5**

#### **SkillsUSA Championships Career Competitions Debriefings**

- Competitors must wear their official competition attire as outlined in the SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards

#### **Awards Session**

- SkillsUSA Official attire or Class B-I Competition specific attire as outlined in the SkillsUSA Championship Technical Standards.
