AWARDS CEREMONY DRESS CODE

EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS

Supplied by technical committee:

- Architectural drafting workstation, consisting of a table with a work area, space for reference materials and a personal computer, and a chair
- Access to power
- All necessary information and furnishings for judges

Supplied by the competitor:

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- Preparation of drawings will include proper dimensions and line type selection according to current drafting standards.
- During the competition, the competition will work independently.
- Limited technical assistance for computer or software malfunction may be given by appropriate manufacturers' representatives or members of the tech committee.
- Each competitor will be responsible for establishing plotting procedures at the computer and for plotting his or her work to a plot file on a removable storage device.
